

Living Hope For Honduras December 27 - January 3, 2018

About This Project



This Team will serve with Living Hope, which serves the city of Gualaco and many villages in the region of central Olancho, known as the Agalta Valley. The compound is roughly four hour drive from Tegu.

What are the accommodations? Living Hope maintains a secure compound in Gualaco that includes beds for up to thirty people, hot water, towels and linens, a water treatment system, dining hall, cooks, security guards, laundry services, backup electricity generators, hand tools, concrete mixers, power tools, welding shop, meeting spaces, and office area, and local assistance (concrete finishers, carpenters, storage areas, electricians, etc. to insure each group's mission objectives can be met).

What will we eat? You will be eating Honduras food including beans, chicken, coffee, and other meals provided by the ladies at the compound.

What should I wear? Comfortable clothes that you don't mind getting dirty while out working. It will not be cold, so shorts and t-shirts are acceptable clothing. Most people bring along tennis shoes or sandals can be worn while not working. Laundry services will be provided.
